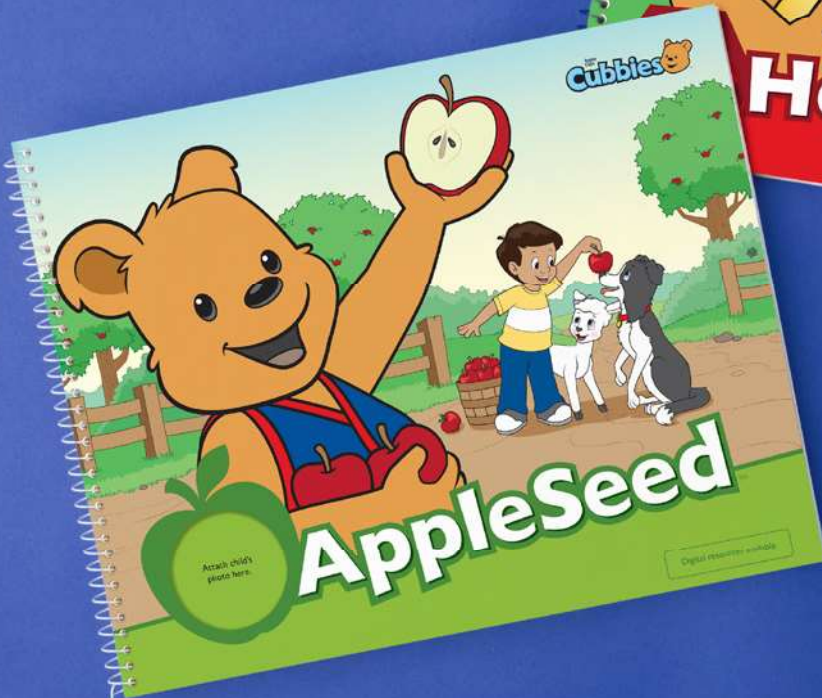
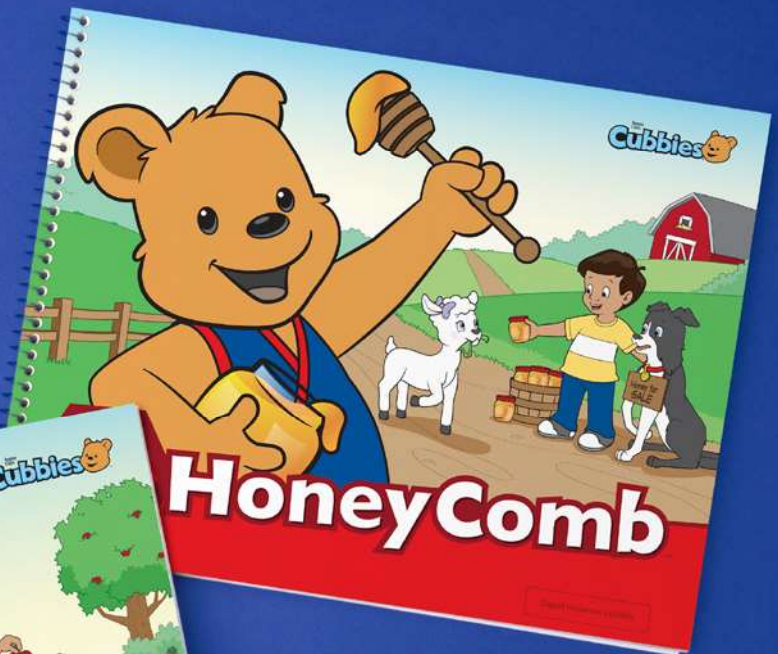
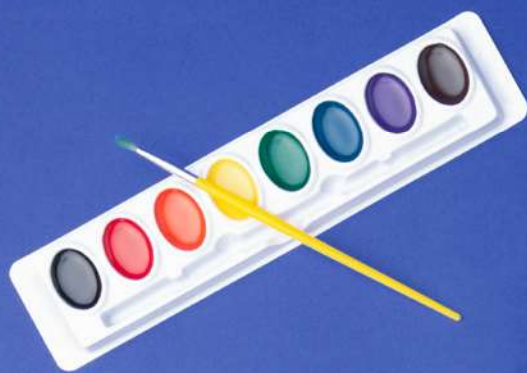

What is Cubbies?

Awana Cubbies® celebrates the spiritual potential of preschoolers by helping them develop respect for God, His Son, and His Word. Lessons (called Bear Hugs) include memory verses, Bible lessons, and activities that teach basic core truths about God, Jesus, and salvation. Multiple options allow leaders to choose what works best for their group. Creative learning activities encourage parent-child interaction at home.

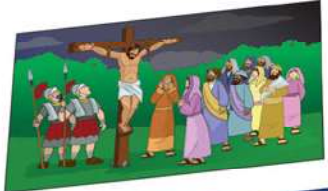

Christ Died for Us

Bible Reference: Romans 5:8
Listen. I'm going to say two C words from our story today. (Say the words **Cubbie** and **comb**, emphasizing the **C** sound in each word.) Both **Cubbie** and **comb** start with **C**. What sound does **C** make? (Make the **C** sound together.) Now let's look in the Bible to find the most important **C** word of all.
(Open your Bible to **Romans 5:8**.) The Bible is God's special book. God talks to us in the Bible. Listen and tell me when you hear the word that starts with **C**. **Romans 5:8** says: **I** You're right. The word **Christ** starts with **C**. (Let your child find the **C** in **Christ** in the verse on the opposite page.) **Christ** is another name for God's Son, **Jesus**. We sometimes call Him **Christ** or **Jesus Christ**.
God sent **Jesus Christ** to live on earth. (Point to the first picture below.) **Jesus** loved everyone. He loved children, like you, very much! (Hug your child to express **Christ's** love.)



(Point to the second picture.) **Jesus** showed His love in a **BIG** way when He died for us on the cross. Let's say the verse together: **I** **Jesus Christ** had to be done about our sin. **God** sent His Son, **Jesus Christ**, to die for our sin. **Jesus** chose to die for our sins because He loved us so much. (If your child can understand, explain the concept of punishment. The punishment for sin is death. **Jesus** died to take our punishment.)
(Point to the third picture.) **Jesus** did not stay dead. On the third day (hold up three fingers), **Jesus Christ** came alive again! Then He went back up to heaven to be with His Father, **God**.
Here's the best part! Anyone who trusts **Christ** as **Savior** can go to heaven someday and live there with Him forever! Let's say our verse again: **I** (Explain that "trusting **Christ** as **Savior**" means you believe and accept **Christ's** death for your sin. Let your child ask questions, without pressuring for a response to the gospel.)

ParentPause
Preschoolers can trust **Christ** as **Savior**. Often the ones that trust Him have heard consistent and frequent explanations of the gospel at home and church. However, young children are very eager to please adults, so adults must never pressure a child to make this important decision.

Memorize

All Cubbies learn the same version of this verse.

TRACK 7
Romans 5:8
... While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Memory Tip: With one hand, draw a cross or a **C** in the air as you say "Christ died for us."

Cubbie, trace the letter **C**. What is the Bible word that starts with **C**?
